

## Additional comments from Wicklewood Village Survey

<b>Comment</b>	<b>Council response</b>
Shop – 3 people commented	This would be private enterprise – the council would look favourably on an appropriate planning application
Lack of community spirit	This has already been identified, lack of response to community activities. The council would continue to support community events
Footpath along Church Lane – 2 people commented	Church Lane is not a wide enough road to enable a footpath to be built
Unable to use verge outside 33/35 Church Lane – 2 people commented	This is an ongoing issue that the council is regularly in communication with Highways about
Move bus stop so not at junction	Considered the position is appropriate and would cause potential problems wherever it was placed
Bus stop near supermarket	The bus already stops near Waitrose
Bus shelter	The council is already considering installing a shelter, budget allowing
Promotion of events at village hall	This is the responsibility of the people holding the events. Most are advertised in The Net and local social media
People in the fields	This was a historic issue with youths causing problems. Not believed to be ongoing
Dog bins	There are already two dog bins in the village
Footpath both sides of pub	This is not possible as the land to the side is privately owned
Volume of parties – regulating of hours	The hall is only bookable up to midnight. Hirers are asked to leave quietly.
Removal of overhanging branches on High St – 2 people commented	This is being addressed, see January Minutes
Pot holes and parking in Low Street	Potholes should be reported direct to Highways via the fault reporting facility on the council website. There are no parking restrictions on Low Street so it is not possible to take action
Street lighting	This was considered at the previous council meeting and rejected as not generally wanted
Lorries through village	Council has no jurisdiction over this
Less houses being built	Council has no jurisdiction over this. There are government targets to increase housing in the area
The road needs something doing	In general it was felt that the roads in the village are in reasonable condition for rural roads. Pot holes should be reported direct to Highways, see above
Phone mast	Council has no jurisdiction over this
People parking on corner of Hillside	The resident will be asked to stop doing this. (see Minutes)
Tennis court	A tennis court was previously installed but was used so little that it didn't warrant the maintenance costs so was removed.
